### **Please include the following information in this order:**

1. Name, mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address.
2. High school transcript with unweighted GPA.
3. List of all science and health care related courses.
4. Work experience and/or volunteer service related to health care field.
5. School and community activities - include leadership roles, awards/recognition received and other work and/or volunteer activities
6. Essay describing why you are pursuing a career in the health care field, your passions and what challenges you foresee, not to exceed 700 words.
7. Two current letters of reference – one must be from a health care professional.
8. Other educational funding sources i.e. known scholarships, grants etc.
9. Please **do not use staples or binders** when submitting your application.  
Instead keep them loose leafed with a paper clip
10. Type on **one side of paper only**. (no two-sided typed paper please!)
